MeTV Toons (54.3) plays cartoons such as Rocky & Bullwinkle, Looney Tunes, vintage Tex Avery, and Scooby-Doo, Jetsons, Flintstones and other Hanna-Barbera cartoons, along with many other animated shows. These stations add to the extensive lineup of free over-the-air TV channels that are translated into the Ridgecrest and Inyokern area by the IWV TV Booster and can be received by aiming a

good UHF TV antenna at Laurel Mountain; identified by the white radar dome located on the mountaintop south of town. About a quarter of the 81 channels are in high definition (HD). In addition, two local TV stations: Ridgecrest City Channel and Ridgecrest TV station KZGN Ch. 21 are translated. The IWV TV Booster also translates eight FM radio stations into the valley including classical, jazz, rock music, news, public broadcasting and others.

The IWV TV Booster translators on Laurel Mountain receive signals from distant stations in the southern California and Las Vegas areas and retransmits these TV & FM radio signals from Laurel Mountain into the Indian Wells Valley. The IWV TV Booster can only retransmit what is received and must stop transmitting if the originating station goes off the air.

The IWV TV Booster, Inc. is a non-profit all-volunteer organization that has been providing the translation services for free over-the-air TV in the Indian Wells Valley since 1955. The IWV TV Booster volunteers donate their time, energy, and expertise to keep operating, year-round. The IWV TV Booster volunteers are happy to help advise users about TV antenna selection and installation issues. Full listing of all channels is available by contacting IWV TV Booster.

While receiving the signals is free, the IWV TV Booster relies on donations from the community to continue operation by funding equipment repair and purchases, insurance, FCC licensing, and Navy site usage fees.
